

### Show me Tell me Vauxhall Viva

1. Open the bonnet and tell me where you would check the engine oil and how you would check that the engine has sufficient oil.



- a. Identify where the dipstick is.



- b. "The level must be between the minimum and maximum marks".

2. Open the bonnet and tell me where you would check the engine coolant level and how you would check the engine has the correct level.



a. Identify where the expansion tank is



b. "The level must be between the minimum and maximum marks"



3. Open the bonnet and tell me where you would check the brake fluid reservoir and how would you check that you have a safe level of hydraulic brake fluid.



a. Identify the reservoir



b. "The level must be between the minimum and maximum marks"

4. Tell me how you would switch on the rear fog light and explain when you would use it.
- a. "I would set the light switch to dipped headlights, and activate the rear fog light switch".



- b. "It would be used when visibility is below 100 metres"
5. Tell me how you switch your headlights from dipped to main beam and explain how you know the main beam is on whilst inside the car.
- a. "I would push the indicator arm forwards to change to main beam".
- b. "I will have a blue warning light on my dashboard."
6. Tell me how you would check the Headlights and Tail lights are working
- a. "I would operate my light switch and walk around the vehicle"
7. Tell me how you would check the indicators are working.
- a. "I would operate either the Hazard warning switch or the indicator arm, and walk around the vehicle".
8. Tell me how you make sure your Head Restraint is correctly adjusted so it provides the best protection in the event of a crash
- a. "The top of the head restraint must be above the top of the ears"
9. Tell me how you would know if there is a problem with the Antilock Braking System
- a. "I would get a warning light in the dashboard"

10. Tell me how you would check that power assisted steering is working before starting the journey

- a. "I would either add pressure to the steering wheel, start the engine. The wheel should move to show the pump is working."

Or

- b. "The steering wheel should not feel heavy with the engine running."

11. Tell me how you would check that the brakes are working before starting a journey

- a. "I would press the brake pedal to make sure it doesn't feel spongy or slack. I would also test the brakes as I pull away to check it doesn't pull to one side"

12. Tell me how you would check the brakelights are working on this vehicle

- a. "I will operate footbrake pedal"
- b. "I would make use of reflections in windows, garage doors etc, or ask someone to help."

13. Tell me where would you find the recommended tyre pressures for this vehicle and how would you check them

- a. "I would find the pressures in the owner's handbook. I would check all tyres, including the spare, using a reliable pressure gauge. After checking, replace the valve caps.

14. Tell me how you would check the tyres have sufficient tread depth, and the general condition is safe to use on the road.

- a. "There should be no cuts or bulges on the tyre"
- b. "Tread depth MUST BE AT LEAST 1.6mm along the middle  $\frac{3}{4}$  across the crown of the tyre, and around the entire circumference"

15. When safe to do so. Show me how you clean the windscreen using the windscreen wash wipers.

- a. Check mirrors and pull the wiper arm towards you to allow some screen wash to spray on the windscreen and release. Wipers will wipe automatically and switch off automatically.



16. When safe to do so. Show me how you clean the rear window using the rear window wash wipers.

- a. Check mirrors and push the wiper arm forwards to allow some screen wash to spray on the rear window and release. Wipers will switch off automatically.





17. When safe to do so. Show me how to open and close your door window.

a. Check mirrors and operate the window switch by pressing down. Window will open.



b. Check mirrors and operate the window switch by firmly lifting up. Window will close.



18. When safe to do so. Show me how to set the demist controls to clear the front windows effectively.

- a. Check mirrors and press windscreen demist button.

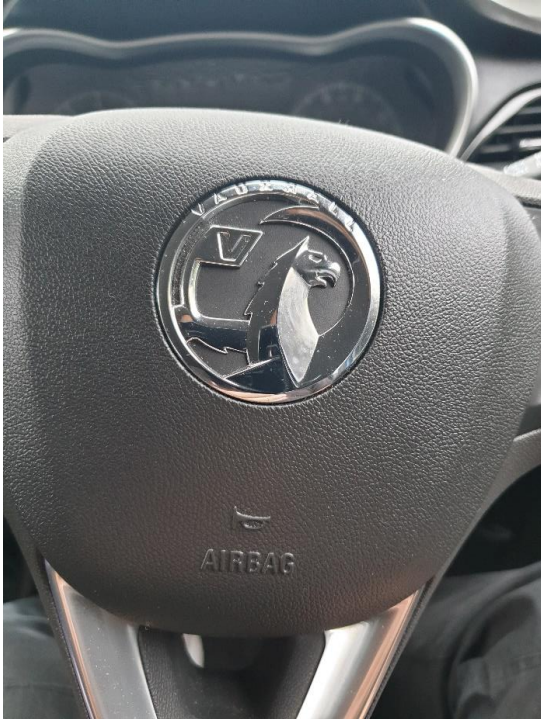
19. When safe to do so. Show me how to set the demist controls to clear the rear windows effectively.

- a. Check mirrors and press the rear window demist button.





20. When safe to do so. Show me how you would check the horn is working.
- a. Check mirrors and surrounding areas to ensure that sounding the horn will not spook animals or people.
  - b. Operate the horn



21. When safe to do so. Show me how you would switch on your dipped headlights.
- a. Check mirrors. Rotate the light switch two clicks to the right.
